Conclusion & Discussion

- Scalable approach? Probably not.
- POIs in Brno:
 - Attribute accuracy is reasonably good
 - Issue with complex string values (e.g., opening_hours)
 - Positional accuracy is reasonably good
 - Incompleteness of attributes and features
 - No universal dependency of data quality and metadata
- ISO 19157
 - Not suitable for comprehensive tag evaluation
 - Custom metric?





Naše přednášky

- User testing of Al-assisted mapping tool fAlr
- Srovnání mapování budov v nástroji fAlr s asistencí Al a manuálního mapování v JOSM.

Results – summary

- fAlr is a beginner-friendly tool.
 - Beginners have similar results in fAIr as experienced contributors, sometimes even better.
 - Users appreciated the simple interface.
 - It is suitable for quick mapping of simple features.
- fAlr did not offer proper outlines of buildings with complex shapes.
 - These problems were greater in the complex localities (high density of buildings and/or low quality of the imagery).
- Participants suggested combining both tools starting with quick mapping in fAIr and refining the quality in JOSM.
- Participants believe that fAIr has the potential to improve the mapping process and could be helpful if key problems are addressed.


